If your windows need tough love, add two tablespoons of household ammonia, but wear rubber gloves. Buffing your clean, dry glass with crumpled newspaper gives windows a sparkling finish.~~

~~Below are a few choice tips, along with her vinegar window-washing recipe. Mix one part hot water to one part distilled vinegar. Sponge cleaning: Moisten the window, using the solution, then clean. Squeegee cleaning: Always dampen the squeegee first and clean from the top down, wiping the edge of the squeegee after every stroke. Clean only when there is no direct sun on the windows. Rinse and dry the window frames immediately to avoid any damage.~~

Mix a strong vinegar solution. If you've never cleaned your windows with vinegar before, you might want to mix up a slightly stronger vinegar solution for your first attempt. Mix two cups (480 mL) water, ¼ cup (60 mL) white vinegar (you can also use apple cider vinegar), and ½ teaspoon (2.5 mL) of dishwashing detergent.

The Best Way to Clean Windows Ideally, windows should be washed twice a year, but it's a task most people don't look forward to. Part of what makes DIY window cleaning such a chore is that homeowners insist on doing it with wadded-up paper towels or newspaper, spray cleaner, and a ton of elbow grease.

Instead of cleaning right away with vinegar and/or ammonia-based solutions, first clean the windows with a soap and water solution. Once you have removed the majority of the debris, and then use the homemade window washing solution for the final step.

Spray your window with this solution. 3 Scrub (if windows are really dirty) window with the sponge/scrubber side of a squeegee. This step is not necessary if the windows are not really dirty.

While both ammonia and vinegar are good ingredients, separately, for making window cleaning solutions, it does not make an even better cleaner to combine them together.
